This program is executed by The Punjab Educational Endowment Fund (PEEF). Separate funds are allocated annually for this program by Government of the Punjab.

Ph.D Foreign Scholarship Program

- 30 Scholarships annually
- 90% quota for Punjab students while 10% quota for other federating units
- Admission in Top 50 QS Ranked (subject wise) Universities
- Age limit 35 years
